I will walk to my Dragon Den with my buddy if I have one. My Dragon Den might be another teacher's classroom or it might be another room in the school. My Dragon Den will be in the same place with the same teacher and most of the same kids over the course of the year. If my Dragon Den teacher is absent, my teacher will tell me to stay in my regular classroom.

Once all the students are at their Dragon Den, there will be a welcome from the Dragon Den teacher and some kind of warm up game. Next the teacher will have a read aloud followed by a snack. Then there will be an arts and craft activity. Sometimes there will be a coloring sheet for students who finish early. Some students may

have a different activity in their plan. If I need a break, the teacher will show me what and where the break options are. I can always ask a safe adult for help.

Everyone will be dismissed by an announcement on the intercom. I will listen for when it is my grade's turn to go. If I walked a little buddy to Dragon Den, I will return them to their classroom before walking to mine.
